INTRODUCTION TO CLASS

Welcome Saints of God

- It is clear that God is preparing the Bride of Christ
- What we are doing (as the Bride) is “making ourselves ready” (Rev. 19:7)
- How different this preparation has been than professional development in the natural - there’s a weightiness and heart tenderness about it; it’s holy.
- When I even think about His end goal with this - not specifically this class but with His Holy Spirit in each of us, I get completely melted. I’m excited for me. I’m excited for you. I’m excited for our assembly. I’m in shock and awe.
- In addition to what He intends to do (and what I believe has already begun) in each of us individually, I believe He is giving us what we will be giving to new believers in His harvest, when He begins to draw and to send people to our (or any) assembly. He wants more than a tour of yester-year. He wants a now-Word and an impartation of His glory for anyone He sends or brings, and it will be our privilege and our honor to give out of what He has given us.

Structure of the Class - Follow the Holy Spirit. Here is how He led me to deliver the class sessions:

- ***If you are using these session notes with the podcast, please be aware that every podcast episode is only one-half of a teaching session. In other words, each handout covers two podcast episodes.***
- We started our sessions by playing one song (the name of which is provided at the beginning of each class’s handout). We sat together silently and meditated on the message of the song and welcomed the Holy Spirit. Our class did not have a worship set, but if yours does, that will likely be sufficient.
- We punched 3 holes in each session’s handout so they could be kept in a 3-ring binder. We added notebook paper so everyone could record the revelation they began to receive.
- “Homework” is provided so participants will or can continue their never-ending conversations with the Godhead throughout their week.
- Notecard at end of session - I asked participants to write down one take-away from the session and hand it in. I read many of these at the beginning of the next session to call up what was presented into our consciousness the following week or session. People get to hear what others are experiencing. Questions and concerns can be addressed.

SESSION ONE (Podcast episodes 1)

Music: ***Now Behold the Lamb***, Kirk Franklin

Welcome, Holy Spirit

When we announced the class a week ago, I asked who wanted to see and hear more of God than they were currently, and then I asked why. Tonight, I'd like to think about it from the Holy Spirit's point of view.

Why does the Holy Spirit want us to see and hear Him?

- He's our Teacher
- He loves us; He wants intimacy with us
- He wants a Bride prepared for Jesus
- He wants effective laborers for His harvest
- He wants to bring the Body of Christ to maturity
- He wants us to realize our unique creation and our destiny / purpose in God
- He wants us to stay encouraged and enthused about the things of God
- He wants to equip us to persevere
- He wants us to know Him and to enjoy Him
- He wants to help deliver us and keep us from enemy attacks and influences
- He wants to co-labor with us in the plans and purposes of God
- He has answers that He wants to express
- He is the only One who can bring heaven to earth, the only One who can reveal and build the Kingdom of God in us, through us, and around us
- He knows we need revelation: *My thoughts are not your thoughts; neither are your ways My ways.* (Is. 55:8)
- He wants us to have everything we need in order to abound to every good work (2 Cor. 9:18)
- He wants to reveal to us "the deep things of God."

****Get used to reading scripture slowly, contemplatively; take it in like scrumptuous food; don't bolt it down without tasting it. (Read twice; read aloud to yourself)***

1 Corinthians 2:9-16

(9) But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. (10) **But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit:** for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. (11) For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? Even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

(12) Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. (13) Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. (14) **But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.** (15) But he that is spiritual judgeth all things yet he himself is judged of no man. (16) For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ.

What are some reasons even saved people experience resistance or reservation toward seeing and hearing God?

Put a checkmark next to any that are true for you.

1. **Fear of deception** - if you are trying to protect yourself from the supernatural attributes of God, that is your deception. You are more deceived to elevate the natural above the spiritual where God is concerned.
2. **Fear of the supernatural (demonic or angelic)** - a device of the enemy because you can't even explain it. This is an irrational fear. Kick it out.
3. **Fear of demons manifesting in me / Fear of seeing what's in me**
4. **It's too good to be true.** ("If I don't believe, I won't have to be disappointed.") This is the fact about the Lord - He IS too good to be true, but He IS true!
5. **I don't qualify** (condemnation); that's for other, more special people. What we think we believe with our minds may not be what is in our hearts. And only heart status counts in the spirit realm. We have to keep praying to get the renewal we want in the belief in our hearts. While that's happening, we tend to give up. That's the device of the enemy - to whisper failure and fear of failure to us while we are waiting on God and exercising faith. (Faith that is seen is not faith. You SHALL REAP if you faint not. In week 3, we're going to go in on condemnation; and you will enjoy new, true belief in your heart that you have not known before.)
6. **That's a gift I don't have.** What you believe is true for you, but we will read scripture shortly that says differently. This is not a unique gift for only a few. This is the children's bread. You wouldn't say in your family, "I don't have the gift to hear and see my parents. I don't see and hear my parents. That's for my more gifted siblings, not me."
7. **It doesn't fit my paradigm;** some of us were taught that supernatural experiences (tongues, prophecy) are not for today. Your attending class and seeking God will take care of this. Good teaching will undo bad teaching; it may be the only way to undo it. If it is true teaching, the Bible and the Holy Spirit will confirm it. I'm not worried about this one unless you are not persuaded by higher facts or higher realities. If you really want truth, you will get it.
8. **I don't want to be considered weird.** It's worth it. That's a conditioned soul, low-living programming. Do you hold contempt for people who abandon self for God? Do you judge them as weird? We are judged by how we judge.

9. ***Our prior negative experiences or someone else's negative experiences with prophecy.*** it's possible that the negative experiences were in the hearer / receiver as much as in the prophet. Never discount God's gifts and provision because of human error.
 10. ***I've tried to hear God and can't.*** We will deal with blockages. The important issue is not what has not been before but in how much you want it now. Let the delay - no matter the reason - work to increase your desire - even to the point of desperation.
 11. ***The voice I hear just sounds like me*** (and I'm not impressed with my own voice). Most of the time that God speaks in your thoughts, it will sound like you. Once you have practice, you will realize that you could have trusted that voice a long time ago had you known its origin. The more you surrender your thought life to the Holy Spirit, the more you will trust that He really does operate through your thoughts.
- *Share with a neighbor any resistance or reservation you have had toward seeing and hearing God.*

Episode 1 ends here, and there is no further recording to deliver what follows, but you can read it..

What does the Bible say about hearing and seeing God?

Put a checkmark next to the verses that speak loudest to you tonight.

*Also, **picture a newly tilled garden.** The ground is marked off. The soil is all turned up and cleaned out of all weeds and sticks. It's been cultivated. It's rich, dark soil, ready for seed. This is an image of your heart tonight. As we read each verse, it will be sown into the soil of your heart. It will be lovingly received by the garden of your heart, tucked into the soil, and it will produce good fruit in your life. In fact, we decree that these seeds will grow supernaturally quickly, as described in Amos 9:13 "Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when the plowman will overtake the reaper and the treader of grapes, the sower of seed. The mountains will drip with sweet wine, with which all the hills will flow." Now, when we read the Bible, we can and must expect all the scripture that references a "day that is coming" as this day, our day. There are few prophecies on earth's timeline left to be fulfilled. The time is now.*

1. **John 3:3** Jesus answered and said unto him (Nicodemus), Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

2. **Isaiah 50:4-5** The Lord GOD hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to *him that is weary*: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned / as a disciple. The Lord GOD hath opened mine ear, and I was not rebellious, neither turned away back.

3. **John 8:47** He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear *them* not, because ye are not of God.

4. **John 16:13** When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.

5. **John 14:26** But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I (Jesus) have said to you.

6. **Rev. 3:20** Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me.

7. **Acts 22:14** (Ananias to Saul): **14** And he said, 'The God of our fathers appointed you to know his will, to see the Righteous One and to hear a voice from his mouth.'

8. **John 10:3-4** **3** To him the gatekeeper opens. The sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. **4** When he has brought out all his own, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice.

9. **Matt. 5:8** Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

10. **I John 3:2** Beloved, we are God's children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared; but we know that when he appears we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is.

- *Share with a neighbor any scripture in this list that was highlighted to you.*

The Language of God

The language of God is not primarily English. It's not primarily speech. It's images, smells, tastes, emotions, eye contact, thoughts, snippets, scripture chapter and verse, phrases, song lyrics. He's always talking, but He wastes no words. It takes Him very few words to communicate a truth or to send you on a search for meaning. The message comes into focus slowly, usually, as you ponder it. There will be enough communicated to start you on a "searching out" of the matter.

- He will highlight a written word (scripture, a book or article, a billboard, a note, etc.)
 - Recently he captured my attention with the word "Wheat" on a billboard.
 - As you are waking is a key time to hear God. At least half of all I have received comes to my mind as I wake. But these times are like waking from dreams. If you don't write it down quickly, you will lose it. I've lost it from bed to chair. If I don't have pen or paper or I don't want to fully wake, I speak the details into a voice recorder on my phone.
- He will highlight a spoken word (your own, someone else's - whether intentional or not)
- He will call your attention to a matter by repeating Himself - the witness of "2"
- He will give a dream.

- He will give a vision.
 - In a vision, you are normally awake. You watch a drama play out in your imagination; it's like a waking dream. I've learned to pay attention to these and to converse with God about what I see, to participate, to accept, to decree, to ask for understanding, to respond in some way.
- He will show you an evil presence.
 - In Israel, I saw inky beings hanging all over the Palestinian "holy" place on the temple mount. They were jeering and scoffing at us. I also saw all of us with a bell jar of glory covering us from head to foot everywhere we went - for protection, I thought, but God said, "also to serve notice that their time is short."
 - Inky beings uncovered from their "close places" walked to a spotlight to be judged
 - A chief of a first nations tribe - a cultural-identity idol
- He will show you an angelic presence. Among others, I have seen a/an . . .
 - Entity with eyes and a stance like an eagle.
 - Angel over the gate to the city of KC
 - Angel over the school district offices
 - Watchers, then a centurion
 - A cloud of blessing over a school building
 - Angels standing in the children's classroom with an ambassador-leader
- He will appear to you Himself.
 - Jesus has appeared to me many times. I told you about how he appeared to me in my room before Israel and told me he couldn't wait to show me Jerusalem.
 - I had humbled myself by lying on the floor in my room. I wanted something from the Lord, probably to get closer to him. He got down on the floor with me and sought out my eyes with his - pure love poured through His eyes.
 - When I go up to the "door standing open in heaven" - Jesus is the first one there - I finally realized that's because He IS the door.
 - "The cavalry are coming" + "Faithful and true" = Jesus riding with the saints
 - He may give you an interaction with a member of the cloud of witnesses
- He will play a song, or a part of a song, in your spirit.
 - So often - really fun. I have always loved what we would call now old R&B, and I know a ton of songs from the late 60's and 70's. I know a lot of gospel songs, too.
 - "And my answer will be yes, Lord, yes." 3 days in a row
 - "I want what you want. You want what I want. We were made for each other" (Forever Mine, by the O.J.'s - other lyrics say, "Forever mine, cuz you're my kind")
 - Another song I remember well is the sappy love song "Endless Love" - listen to the lyrics though:

Two hearts,
 Two hearts that beat as one
 Our lives have just begun

Forever
(ohhhhhh)
I'll hold you close in my arms
I can't resist your charms

And love
Oh, love
I'll be a fool
For you,
I'm sure
You know I don't mind
Oh, you know I don't mind

'cause you,
You mean the world to me
Oh
I know
I know
I've found in you
My endless love

- He will give you a scripture or a phrase or a word from the Bible.
 - In my 20's, I fasted (from coffee and cigarettes!) to seek the baptism of the Holy Spirit - I saw "I Cor. 15:7" written with smoke in the sky and heard, "I am not a smoker now" and was immediately freed from nicotine.
 - 30 years later, I saw my Professor at a whiteboard. He'd written Col. 2:9, which was too high a concept when I first read it but has become a constant prayer over the past several years.
- He will place an invisible item in your hand or put something on you in the spirit.
 - Four seeds - mustard seeds
 - Golden headband
 - Whip
 - Handful of feathers - buy a feather pillow
 - Blue plastic cheerleader's megaphone with a flame of fire decal
- He will make his presence known in or on some part of your body
- He will give you an urge to buy or acquire something specific (prophetic shopping)
 - "Gather" (wooden cut-out of the word) from Hobby Lobby led to Paul Keith Davis's *Angels that Gather* and also related to a deluge of teaching he was giving me on wheat and tares and harvest - it led to an investigation of God's calendar, His supernatural blessing in the feasts, all of which are about some form of gathering.
 - This wasn't shopping directly, but it had a similar effect - I had bought a set of safari animals for a 3-year-old who was staying with us - the set had a tiger, a giraffe, a lion, and an elephant. A few weeks later they moved out and took all their stuff, obviously. At the time, the Lord was showing me what he called "elephants in the room" in a particular area of the school district. For several days he showed me what he wanted declared for the school system, and much of it

had this theme of elephants in the room, as in, “Let’s address the elephant in the room.” During this time, I went downstairs to straighten up after my guests had moved out, and I found behind a chair the elephant from this set of animals. That joined my prophetic articles on my dresser.

- You may see an image of yourself in particular clothing or doing something new
- A scene may play out in your imagination, like a waking dream
- He may tell you to ask Him for something - (“Ask to meet the Apostle Paul.”)
- You may find yourself engaged in a preaching flow while by yourself (car or shower)
 - I’m always preaching - to myself, my kids, my students, an unknown audience - and what comes out is a compilation of recent revelations - God is making sure I have internalized His revelation to me. Many times I’m prophesying.
- Others?

What will keep us from seeing or hearing God?

- Sin
- Iniquity (bloodline sin)
- Legalism / religion
- Condemnation
- Idolatry
- Unforgiveness
- Pride
- Taking Offense
- Unbelief (What does Jesus believe can happen?)
- Nay-saying (many of these postures or conditions are common when the soul is ascendant over the spirit)
- Limitations on God
- Programming (from tradition or religious teaching)
- Complaining
- Not caring; detachment (scar tissue) - Jesus chooses to stay vulnerable to us, keeps caring even when the object of His desire, that He gave everything for, doesn’t even want to see or hear Him. We have to care about that, and we have to care about what He cares about.

Isaiah 59:2 But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, And your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear.

Gal. 5:4 You have been severed from Christ, you who are seeking to be justified by law; you have fallen from grace.

Psalms 66:18 If I regard wickedness in my heart, The Lord will not hear.

Psalm 124:3-4 Who may ascend the mountain of the Lord? Who may stand in his holy place? The one who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not trust in an idol or swear by a false god.

Matt. 6:15 But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

Mark 7:20-23 And he said, "What comes out of a person is what defiles him. For from within, out of the heart of man, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, coveting, wickedness, deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride, foolishness. All these evil things come from within, and they defile a person."

Habakkuk 2:4 Behold, as for the proud one, His soul is not right within him; But the righteous will live by his faith.

James 4:6 and **I Peter 5:5** ... God opposes the proud, but He gives grace to the humble.

The Importance of the "Homework" Assignments

- This requires a proof of desire - God's words to us are so valuable and so holy that we must want them desperately. We have to come to realize that they are the most important thing in our lives. We cannot live without them. They are worth everything - worth our whole lives. There is no life without them. Only then will we value them as He deserves. In the waiting, he is developing your relationship with Him. Not one minute is wasted. Many times, I am lovesick for Him - even when He is right there. But that took a lot of tenderizing, a lot of sensitizing. It makes us become desperate to get all hindrances removed. We end up praying, "Whatever it takes, God, just do it." We cannot hold ourselves aloof from God in any way.
- We will never come into the level of constant communion with the Lord if we do not give ourselves to that pursuit during our own time throughout the week. You realize your time IS your life, right? What are you spending your life on? Even good things are not good things if they keep us from this one pursuit. It's not that they are not allowed to you. It's that you choose a lesser level with God when you choose any other thing before Him.
- Attending services with the corporate body will not produce your ability to see and hear God because that comes out of your intimacy with Him, and that, by definition, means just you and Him.
- No one can do your journey but you. Opting out of it is opting out of life, out of calling, out of the most important relationship you'll ever have.
- These exercises are to help you as you pursue God during your own time - between services and classes. I intend always to spend considerable time on these because this is where you will reap fruit from our endeavors here.

“Homework” Exercises and Activities

- I. Frame up your fellowship time with the Lord: Write a detailed description of the kind of special fellowship time you would like to have with Holy Spirit - How often would you meet? What time of day? Where? How do you plan to worship? To pray? To listen? For how long will you meet? What part(s) of the Bible might you read? What concepts or questions would you like the Holy Spirit to address for you?

Be sure to write this description as though it is already taking place, like this:

*“I rise each **morning** by 5:00 a.m. and give thanks to God. I tell Him how much He means to me and how beautiful, majestic, and desirable He is. I describe Him using Psalms of adoration. I sing the song He puts in my spirit...etc.*

“I pray in tongues for more and more minutes each day. At the leading of the Holy Spirit, I become still and silent before my God, and I listen for His voice, realizing that His voice speaks in images, in phrases, in a word, in a song lyric, in an emotion...etc.

*“**Throughout the day**, I turn my thoughts to my Companion and my Guide, Holy Spirit. He speaks to me. I respond. We share an ongoing conversation throughout each day and over the span of days. Miracles, signs, and wonders flow out of me like a river because the river of the Holy Spirit flows in and through me . . . etc.*

*“In the **evening**, I pray in tongues for at least 10 min., which increases daily. I take communion, remembering the death of Jesus on the cross and what He accomplished for me, so that I am free of sin, free of condemnation, free of all sickness and disease, free of all fear and torments. I have the fullness of the Holy Spirit infused throughout my being so that I have all power over all the power of the enemy, especially unbelief. I believe everything Jesus died to see manifested in my life and in my family’s life. This is what I declare every evening as I am further transformed by recognizing the death and resurrection of my Savior.”*

Read your description through as a prayer as often as you think of it . . . until it begins to manifest in your daily life. Often, God’s talking TO us takes the form of God talking THROUGH us. Before you sit down to write this, simply pray, “Lord, I’m going to write this out. Please make sure that this is how you want us to begin this journey together.” You may be surprised by what you end up writing. Notice it. Thank God for speaking.

- II. Participate in the Holy Spirit’s Purification of Your Heart: Ask God to search your heart for any of the hindrances listed above. Repent of anything He shows you, no matter how big or small. Pray through the scriptures provided with that list and/or others you find on the topic. (This is our overview prayer. I believe many of you will begin to see and hear God concerning this area even this week. Be sure to write down what He

gives you. In coming classes, we'll be addressing individual items on the list, but for this week, ask God to show you areas He sees as hindrances to your hearing Him. If your heart is sincere, that is a prayer that is irresistible to God.)

- III. Fast from empty "entertainment" (or sleep, or busy-ness) in order to begin fulfilling the fellowship time you described in exercise #1. "God is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him," and nothing is more riveting than seeing and hearing Him. Seek to put time with the Lord first instead of whenever you can get to it. (Because we so seldom get to it.) We are wanting a transfer of our attention and our time - our lives - into the spirit realm so that the majority of each day is spent in communion with God rather than the minority. This is the warfare, more than even resisting known or exposed sin.
- IV. Thank God that you can see and hear Him. Decree as true the scriptures that tell you you can see and hear Him. Thank Him as though it is already happening. (Example: *I thank You, Jesus, that I am your sheep and You are my Shepherd. I know your voice. I hear You very well.* Etc.)
- V. Practice sitting quietly, listening and looking for Him. Write down anything you even *think* you see or hear. Join that conversation as if it really is the Holy Spirit speaking. Ask, "Did I just see that? What else can you show me about that? What does that mean? What is its significance?" If you speak in tongues, pray for more and more minutes each day. We will be discussing more about this later in the course.

Just because you are sitting quietly and expecting to hear and see something right now doesn't mean it's going to come like that. Often, I will get an interpretation of a lengthy tongues-prayer later in the day or in the next couple days. Frequently, I will be surprised when He speaks. That's part of our training, learning to listen and watch for Him at all times of the day. That's part of what "pray without ceasing" means."

Bring something out of your experience to share next week, even if it is, "I tried the exercises 3X but I never saw anything. . . yet." We are just getting started.

Notecards: one take-away from this class session; any question or concern

Closing prayer: include request for increased hunger / desire; intimacy - Oh Lord, you have searched me and known me (Ps. 139)

X. Back to Session 1: The Importance of the homework

- The homework is more important than the class; the purpose of the class is so you can get this in your home / daily walk
- Class teaches, imparts, encourages, builds faith
- Home is where the real action is (you don't want to be one who is "always learning but never coming into the knowledge of the truth" 2 Tim. 3:7)

XI. Week 2 Homework:

- A. Continue to frame up and/or to pray into your ideal fellowship time with the Lord. Continue to meet Him daily, to thank, praise and worship and to sit quietly waiting on Him to speak or show you something. You will come to know Him as "your exceeding great reward" (Gen. 15:1)
- B. Continue to fast from empty entertainment, sleep, or busy-ness until you break through the habitual slavery to earth's gravity/drudgery/toil and realize a new freedom of entering the rest of God, true fellowship with God, and another level of intimacy with God.

- C. Continue to record everything you see or hear from God - to show that you value it, and to discover what He is actually saying to you. Also, some of the things He says come in riddles or partial clues.
1. Deut. 29:29 The secret things belong to the Lord our God; but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.
 2. Prov. 25:2 It is the glory of God to conceal a matter and the glory of kings to search it out.
- D. Participate in the Holy Spirit's purification of your heart: Allow the Holy Spirit to prick your conscience about any of the demons relating to pride in the following list. Pray your own deliverance prayer from all aspects of pride by repenting from and renouncing any that you detect through the light of God. Afterward, pray your own infilling prayer by decreeing you are filled with humility and a heart of submission to God. (A prayer full of scripture is included below.)

Hidden pride is comparison - comparing ourselves to someone else, elevating ourselves over another. Gossip, slander, ambition, jealousy, and anger all have roots in pride.

Heavenly Father, You told me that if I, one of Your people who are called by Your name, will humble myself and pray and seek your face and turn from my wicked ways, that You would hear from heaven and will forgive my sins and restore my land. (2Ch 7:14) Your hands have made both heaven and earth; they and everything in them are Yours. You have spoken! You bless me because I have a humble and contrite heart, and because I honor your Word. (Isa.

66:2) The ones who mock Your ways, it comes right back on them, but You are gracious to me for being humble. (Prov 3:34) I have found out that haughtiness goes before destruction; but humility precedes honor. (Prov 18:12) Even when the prideful cry out, Father, You don't answer them, because of their pride. (Job 35:12) You, Father, have shown me repeatedly that the wicked are brought down into the dust, but You always support the humble. (Psa 147:6) You, Lord God, are great, and You care for the humble, but You keep Your distance from the proud. (Psalm 138:6) People should know that pride leads to disgrace, but with humility comes wisdom. (Prov 11:2) You have restored and given courage to me because I have a repentant heart and am humble. (Isa 57:15) You always rescue the humble. (2Sa 22:28) Your prophet Daniel, was an example to me that if I humble myself before You, Lord God, and pray for understanding, that You will hear from heaven and answer my prayers. (Dan 10:12) I don't live by the things I have obtained or eat, but by every Word that proceeds from You, Father God. (Matt 4:4) Fear of You, LORD, teaches me Your wisdom; humility precedes honor. (Prov 15:33) Your Word, Father, warns me that there is more hope for a fool than for people who think they are wise. (Prov 26:12) Jesus, you explained that You did nothing without the Father either showing You or telling You. (Joh 5:30) So I should let this same attitude and purpose and humble mind be in me which was in You, Lord Jesus: [I will let Jesus be my example in humility] (Php 2:5) As You, Father, sent my Lord into this world, so You, Lord Jesus, have sent me into this world. (Joh 20:21) So I give thanks to You, Father God, for everything in the name of my Lord Jesus Christ. (Eph 5:20) You, Father, must become greater and greater, in my decision making, and I must become less and less. (Joh 3:30) The quicker I learn that when I become as humble as a little child, I become great in Your Kingdom. (Matt 18:4) You, LORD, direct my steps, so why should I try to understand everything along the way? (Prov 20:24) In Your book of Proverbs I am told to trust in You, Lord, with all of my heart, and not lean on my own understanding. In all of my ways, I am to acknowledge You, and You will direct my paths. (Prov 3:5,6) That means every decision I make throughout my day without acknowledging You, is pride. It's prideful for me to think that I am smart enough to make the decisions I make every day. This pride always ends in humiliation if I don't deal with it, while being humble brings me honor. (Prov 29:23) Lord, forgive me for this sin (1Jn 1:9). Holy Spirit, I want to be so sensitive to your leading, that as I acknowledge You in every decision I make, knowing that You will give me the wisdom I need. I receive this answer by faith. (Jas 1:5; Mar 11:24) I can't receive anything unless You, Father, give it to me (Joh 3:27). I am encouraged that when I seek Your help, being humble allows me to see You, Father, at work and it brings me joy. (Psa 69:32) You crown the humble with victory, for You delight in Your people. (Psa 149:4) Actually, I am filled with fresh joy from You, Lord, because I have chosen to be humble. (Isa 29:19) I am the one who will survive, because I trust in Your name, Lord, and am humble. (Zep 3:12) Because I am wise and understand Your ways, Father, I prove it by living an honorable life, doing good works with the humility that comes from wisdom (Jas 3:13). So I will always be humble and gentle, patient with everyone, making allowance for other's faults because of Your love in me (Eph 4:2). I won't be selfish or try to impress others. But I will be humble, thinking of others as better than myself (Php 2:3). I have learned that true humility and reverence of You, LORD, leads me to riches, honor, and long life. You keep me in perfect peace because I trust in You, because all of my thoughts are fixed on You (Prov 22:4; Isa 26:3). Since You, Father God, chose me to

be one of Your holy people that You love, I will clothe myself with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience (Col 3:12). I am not going to let my heart be troubled, I will trust in You, Lord (Joh 14:1). So I humble myself before You God by casting all of my cares upon You, for You care for me. Surely, You will exalt me in due time (1Pe 5:6,7). When I humble myself before you, Father God, and resist the devil, he will flee from me (Jas 4:7). God, You are my source of hope, and You fill me completely with Your joy and peace because I trust in You. Therefore I overflow with confident hope through the power of Your Holy Spirit (Rom 15:13). Not that I count myself to have apprehended all the things You have provided, but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, I reach forth unto those things which are before. I will press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in You Lord Jesus (Php 3:13,14). This high calling is to know You, Lord Jesus, intimately and to rely on your wisdom for everything (Php 3:10). Lord, You told me that I can do nothing without You because You are the vine and I am the branch (Joh 15:5). Yet through You, Lord, I can do all things, because you strengthen me (Php 4:13).

III. Exhortation

We have wanted the manifestations of the Holy Spirit in our lives in the form of gifts, callings, ministries, baptisms, signs and wonders, deliverance, miracles, etc. to know our religion is true. Our God is who he says he is. We like Him to prove Himself, to be the winner over the enemy and over all other gods so that we are proved right, and so that we are assured that we're on the right team. Our champions are those who minister with power and have big manifestations. But those aren't God's priorities.

Matthew 7:21-23

"Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? And in thy name have cast out devils? And in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity."

"I never knew you" =

- you didn't give me access to your heart;
- you didn't want to be yoked with me;

- you didn't want to know my heart;
- you kept me out;
- you used me;
- you lied to yourself about me;
- We were not intimate. We were not friends.

Revelation comes from close relationship with God. Just hang with the Lord. Hang closely with Him. All things are from Him, and through Him, and to Him. To demand or fuss or worry or beg for the evidence of the relationship (revelation) - instead of just living in the relationship - would mean we have a false relationship, right? Just lie on your bed, or in your recliner, or on the floor and sing songs to him. Tell him you love him. And then sit or lie silently in His presence. "Wait, I say, on the Lord."

Luke 11:34 The _____ of the body is your eye; when therefore your eye is _____ your whole body shall be illuminated, but if it should be bad, your body also shall be _____.

V. Learning to “read” my scroll.

Like some of you, I've been very keen to learn what is in my scroll; what does my book of life have written in it? Well, I thought I would have a dream or vision of someone, like an angel, opening my scroll, and I would read it like reading words on a page. That didn't happen.

Later, I learned from several visitors to heaven that books in heaven are experiential, not rhetorical. You don't just read words. You experience the story. But if you ask to know what is in your scroll, it will be disclosed to you over time, which means you will be led into it, and you will be conscious of its unfolding.

I'm going to tell you part of my testimony, and I want you to take note of all the ways the Spirit spoke, all the ways he gave me revelation. Also, I want you to note how this thing goes into that thing and that thing goes into this thing, because that's the way the Holy Spirit orchestrates the kingdom.

VI. How did God communicate?

- Relationship with other people (my apostle)
- Song in my spirit
- Answering a question by speaking to my mind
- An insight modeled by another person (lay me down)
- Things put in my hand
- Vision of the Holy Spirit with a scripture written on a whiteboard
- Developing a desire in my heart (to be placed in an assembly)
- Audible voice of a person who is unaware of speaking to me
- Words, seemingly in passing (preaching to ME)
- Appearance of an angelic entity

-- This is all still developing. It's a living thread. It is for freedom that we were set free, but that freedom is to fulfill our destiny!

When He frees us from pride, it is so that He can take us where we could not otherwise go. There is great purpose in our deliverance!

-- Remember how we looked at the Apostle Paul's commissioning last

week: “You're going to know me. You're going to see me. You're going to hear my voice.” (Acts 22) Then, his destiny unfolded as he pursued

Jesus. Our experiences with God are leading somewhere; these are not random, isolated, disconnected revelations.

VII. Activity: Lay me down. Stretch out on the floor, face down with arms outstretched. Listen to music, or not. Pray in tongues, or not. Wait on God to place something in your hand (or speak to you, or show you something).

Try to “catch it” - suspend the urge to analyze and dismiss. Hold the object in your imagination, no matter what it is, and let him talk to you about it. Typically, whatever it is will be found somewhere in the Bible, but if you don’t discern it or interpret it, just wait. Just wait on Holy Spirit and see if he shows you anything else or tells you anything else.

- Do you love God?
- Do you believe He loves you?
- Do you believe He wants to bring his people into their destiny?
- Do you believe He wants to bring you into your destiny for his purposes?
- Do you want to see and hear him?
- Can you lay yourself down for him in this way at this time?

2 Kings 5:13 - Naaman came to Elisha for healing. Elisha sent a messenger to tell him to go dip in the Jordan seven times and he would be healed. Naaman was offended and said, “I thought He will surely come out to me, and stand, and call on the name of the Lord his God, and strike his hand over the place, and recover the leper.” His servants said, “My father, if the prophet had bid thee do some great things, would thou not have done it? How much rather then, when he saith to thee, Wash, and be clean?” Then Naaman did what the man of God told him to do, and he was cleansed of leprosy.

Can you lay down on the floor for Jesus tonight?

- J. I realize that I now sin because I am trying to meet a need.*

III. Deliverance

- A. How many did any soul-cleaning over this week - releasing oppressive images and effects from your soul?
- B. How is a chain constructed?
- C. **The chain God will break tonight:** rejection > promiscuity, pornography, masturbation, perversion > SHAME > rejection > promiscuity, pornography, masturbation, perversion > SHAME > rejection, etc.
- D. Even if we are abstaining from sexual sin, shame will cause us to get stuck in anxiety where our angst drives us to addictions, negative thinking, and unbelief.
- E. Shame works like condemnation to keep us earth-bound, thinking we are "mere men" / nothing special, when we know we are called to take on the image of God Himself. Our heart condemns us so that we have no faith toward God.
- F. When we break Rejection, all the links fall = no chain, no power to bind.

- *Notice what you see and/or hear during our **song of deliverance** to confirm your deliverance or to assure you of His love.*
- We should not be surprised that the Holy Spirit leads us continually to purification; “the pure in heart shall see God” - it takes continual **purification** to qualify us for increased **intimacy**, and it is in the increased intimacy that we **see more and hear more**. So, repentance, forgiving others, and washing our souls clear is called for daily.

Romans 8:10-11

And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken (cause that which was dead to live) your mortal (physical) bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

D. Jesus's Glorified Body - Jesus demonstrated his glorified body to his disciples when he appeared to them for 40 days following his resurrection. Some of the qualities of his glorified body:

1. He could materialize in their midst and/or walk through walls.
2. He could make himself unidentifiable - Mary thought he was the gardener until he said her name. The men on the road to Emmaus did not recognize him until he broke bread.
3. His body carried the scars and wounds of the crucifixion.
4. He could eat food.
5. His body was not a hologram; it had substance: "Handle me."

E. "...your spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at His coming" (I Thess. 5:23):

1. I believe the upgrades, refinements, and transformation of our **physical bodies** will be one aspect of glorification.
2. I believe it will include a manifestation of the mind of Christ in us, a purified alignment of our emotions to Jesus's emotions and to what He cares about, the ability of Jesus to choose the will of the Father (upgrades to our **souls**).
3. I believe it will also come with parallel upgrades and refinements to our human **spirits** as well (including abilities to rule, to serve, to communicate, to give, to exhort, to understand, to exercise wisdom, to be mighty, to counsel, to know God, to fear God, etc.)

F. "When we see him, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is" (I John 3:2) - **glorified!** This is what will happen to us at the coming of Christ - what we call the second coming. We will be filled to all the fullness of the Godhead bodily, along with members of the corporate body.

Some questions I have . . . Things that make you go "Hmmm":

1. Are we being gradually, progressively glorified right now?
2. Have some, or will some, reach beyond the corporate manifestation to take hold of various powers of the "age to come" before the corporate timing of God?
3. Is that age the Kingdom age? The Millennial age? Are those the same time periods?

4. Isn't the wealth transfer a part of the Kingdom age? If we have so much wealth through that transfer, why are we being warned that we won't be able to buy and sell?
 5. When and how will the tribulation come? Is this the same as the perilous times that are supposedly hundreds and hundreds of years away?
 6. If the wealth transfer and the locking away of the demonic for 1000 years is to come soon, then could we have already been in tribulation and not realized all that it was/is? If so, what exactly was/is the tribulation? Who is the Beast and the prophet of the beast? What is/was the mark of the beast? For that matter, what is the mark of God upon His people?
 7. In what way has the antichrist already set up his throne in God's "temple" and defiled it?
- The order and timing of events is important to know, and is probably deeper than what we have been taught before now, for now is the time for revelation of these things. ***Hold your former teaching or understanding lightly. No one has really "gotten" it yet. But the Spirit is surely revealing it in this day.***
 - This is another reason we need to be able to hear from God and see in the Spirit what He wants us to believe for! Let's get beyond seeking God just for ourselves and our immediate families.
 - "Call unto me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things ***which you have not known.***" Jeremiah 33:3
 - (Vision of how the kingdoms of this world could become the kingdoms of our God and of His Christ - example - Donnelly Dragons to Mt. Zion Miracles)
 - Occupy until He comes - "occupy" = "do business"; "make transactions" = take dominion; take authority over enemy territory

- You cannot compartmentalize your heart. You cannot say, "I submit everything that I already have so far, but I'm not going to commit more. I'm keeping my secret sin. I'm keeping my physical ailments. I'm keeping my habits, my crutches. I'm keeping my bloodline iniquity. I'm keeping my ancestral curses. I'm keeping freemasonry. I'm keeping my family traditions. I'm keeping my past hurts."

- If this is the set of your heart, especially when the Holy Spirit is putting His finger on these things, as He is right now, you cannot, then, have Jesus. You are choosing against Him, and you get what you choose.

A. Unhealed Wounds

- Witchcraft develops from unhealed wounds
- Keeping our wounds when Jesus died to heal them is very dangerous
- It will cost you and your loved ones in this life and in eternity
- Holding onto past hurts makes them idols
- Holding onto past hurts makes you unable to resist offenses until you develop “a root of bitterness... that defiles many” (Heb. 12:14-15)

- b. God has provided all we need to get free. He gives grace for a time, but we are responsible for resisting that sin and working the Word against the power behind it.
- c. Jesus will not have a Bride whose diapers need to be changed.

Int. - “take” = take to marry; take and carry along with oneself; take from or out of; to carry away; to appropriate for one’s self; take possession of; select, choose; receive, accept; fetch, conduct, capture; buy, get, infold

So, this verse could be translated: ***Enoch walked in such proximity to God, in such companionship with God, so closely beside God, in God’s keeping and God’s possession, with God so present in his mind, that God took him. He took him to marry him. He took him to carry along with Himself. He took him out of the earth and carried him away for His own self, took possession of him, selected him, chose him, received him, accepted him, fetched him, captured him for Himself.***

- This experience is yet another baptism, because those who go up to be with the Lord in the air on that day are possessed by Him, completely filled with him, submerged in Him.
- What are we to do? Walk with God as Enoch did. Continue more and more in your never-ending conversation with the Godhead.
- Another way to walk more closely with God - tongues, tongues walk.
